SAMI represents the "underrepresented" immigrant; those fleeing violence (asylum seekers) from Mexico, Central America, and beyond -- migrants who travel through Mexico to the U.S. via El Paso, Texas; and those living in the shadows inside the U.S. SAMI provides representation to "DREAMers," individuals who entered the U.S. before age 16 without proper documentation.
